- E. Only exhibits with some intrinsic value will be considered for monetary awards.
- F. Large or small booths are available for Commercial exhibitors and will not be judged. These booths are for display only and will not be eligible for a monetary award.
- G. Exhibit must be in place and ready for judging by 9 a.m. on Monday, October 10th. Judging will take place after that hour. No displays may be removed before Monday, October 17th.
