

JUNIOR BEEF LIVESTOCK SHOW

SHOW RULES AND GUIDELINES:

1. Exhibitors must furnish their own feed, water pails, and bedding.
2. Cattle entered in purebred classes must be registered in exhibitor's name and registration papers must accompany all entries in the purebred classes.
3. All cattle must conform to State Health Requirements. Health certificate or testing is not required for South Carolina cattle.
4. Beef cattle must be halter broken. (Cattle will remain tied during Fair time).
5. The Competitive System of Judging will be used. Judging: Saturday, October 11th at 11:00am. Beef Cattle received Saturday, October 11th by 10:00am and remain on exhibit until after the show. **Note: Cattle come in and leave on the same day. Any cattle removed without permission before completion of the show will forfeit any premiums won.**
6. **Each exhibitor will be required to pay an entry fee of \$5.00 per animal. Make checks payable to Piedmont Interstate Fair. Entry forms must be completed and mailed to the Piedmont Interstate Fair, P.O. Box 4965, Spartanburg, SC 29305. Or emailed to piedmontinterstatefair@att.net. Once form is received you may request a link to pay via card, there will be a 3% convenience fee. Entry forms should be received by September 26th, 2025.**
7. All calves must be at least four months old to be shown for premiums.
8. The Beef Show is open to the following breeds: British Breeds (Angus, Red Angus, Hereford, Shorthorn), Continental Breeds (Simmental, Limousin, Charolais, Gelbvieh, Salers, Maine Anjou, etc.), Bos Indicus (Guzerat, Gir, Brahman, Nellore, etc.). Heifers entered as a commercial Bos Indicus must exhibit Bos Indicus characteristics (hump, large & pendulous ears, excess skin in dewlap & navel) as determined by show officials, and Crossbreds.
9. No beef bulls will be shown or allowed on the fairgrounds.
10. **Exhibitors will need to enter through the cattle gate to check in with show animal and up to 4 (four) guests. Admission will need to be paid for all others. Please be aware that only one vehicle and trailer will be allowed to park behind the barn.**
11. The youth must be able to maintain control of their animal(s) at all times during this event. Parents are not allowed in the Show Ring during judging. Parents entering the ring during judging will result in the exhibitor being disqualified.
12. The Piedmont Interstate Fair Show Manager reserves the right to make decisions concerning or changing rules, regulations, and/or health requirements.
13. Any animal exhibiting any significant visible symptoms of disease or sickness will not be allowed to be unloaded from the vehicle or remain on the fair/show grounds.
14. Premiums are decided by the Fair's Livestock Show Manager/Show Committee based upon available monies. All premium amounts will be determined and awarded following the completion of the show. Premium checks will be mailed at the end of fair week. All decisions by the judge are final.

SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES

Collegiate Showmanship:

Open to youth ages 19 to 21 based on their age as of January 1, 2025.

Senior Showmanship:

Open to youth ages 14 to 18 based on their age as of January 1, 2025.

Junior Showmanship:

Open to youth ages 9 to 13 based their age as of January 1, 2025.

Cloverbud Showmanship:

Open to youth ages 5 to 8 based on their age as of January 1, 2025.

STEER SHOW REGULATIONS

1. Steer calves must be weaned at least 30 days.
2. All steers, regardless of breed or breed combinations, will show together by weight. The minimum acceptable weight shall be 450 lbs. and the maximum allowable weight shall be 1200 lbs. No exceptions. There will be three weight classes. These classes will not have defined limits; rather, the number per class will be determined by the number of entries checked in.
3. All steers will be weighed. Scales will close 30 minutes prior to start of judging. Judging starts at 11:00am.

* Steer classes divided according to weights. Weight ranges to be determined after all feeder steers are weighed in.
